### GAME RESULTS FOR STATS:

- All Teams to report their game(s) results to their Association's results co-ordinator within 24 hours following said game(s)
- Score statistics will be posted on the Website as soon as they are verified by the C.A.S.A Office
- **Game Sheets** are to be **emailed OR TEXTED** to the C.A.S.A. office **within 24 hours of the game(s)** by the results co-ordinator, coach or team manager.

**Notification of schedule changes must be reported to the C.A.S.A office immediately.**

### Game Sheets:

- 2017 game sheets are in 3 part: Top copy remains with the referee, one copy for home coach and one copy for away coach.
- All coaches/managers are requested to fill out a game sheet properly and completely including your team ID number, age group and gender. A complete list of teams and ID numbers will be available to all coaches.

### Team Rosters:

- Rosters are on file with C.A.S.A. for each league team.
- Note players may only play on one team within the season with the exception of playing up ie. U12 player playing for developmental purposes to a U14 team - limited to 3 games. Please refer to C.A.S.A Rules and Regulations for clarification

### Discipline:

- Referee co-ordinators and Referees must report all yellow and red cards to C.A.S.A. Referee TA - Philip Ignacio [dra1casa@gmail.com](mailto:dra1casa@gmail.com) and a copy to C.A.S.A Office within 24 hours following game [casa9@telus.net](mailto:casa9@telus.net). Players playing while under suspension shall result in a fine levied to his/her association.
- Under no circumstances will a protest be accepted on a Referee's decision or interpretation of the Laws of the Game

### Provincial Qualifying Playdowns & Provincial Competitions:

- All league teams shall have the option to enter the C.A.S.A. Provincial Playdown Tournament
- Provincial Playdown Tournament Rules will be posted on the website.
- Winning teams of each Playdown Tournament shall be entered as the C.A.S.A. District team for ASA Provincial Competitions.
- Provincial rosters shall remain the same as rosters entered into the Playdown tournament with the exception of pick-up rules. Contact office for further details on this.

**Cancelled games are the responsibility of the associations involved. Consideration should be given to teams travelling far. Cancellations guideline - 4:30 pm Game day. All rescheduled games must be reported to the C.A.S.A. Office.**
