Lonny is still an active Coach for the Ponoka Storm U13 Tier 3 Girl's team, which his daughter is member of, as well as an assistant Coach for their U11 Coed Team that his son plays on.

Along with his on the field Coaching, he has served two terms as a CASA Vice President, as well as a One-year term on the Alberta Soccer Association as Rural Director. While working two jobs, both in service to his community, since 2022 he has also dedicated his "FREE" time to being the CASA Technical Director.
